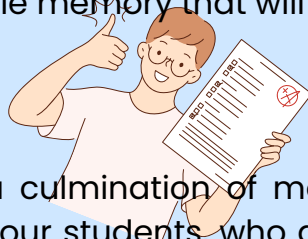


The Musical Night served as a testament to the abundant talent and passion within our school community, leaving an indelible memory that will be cherished for years to come.

The students' determination and the teachers' unwavering support ensured that the exam was a significant step toward their academic success.

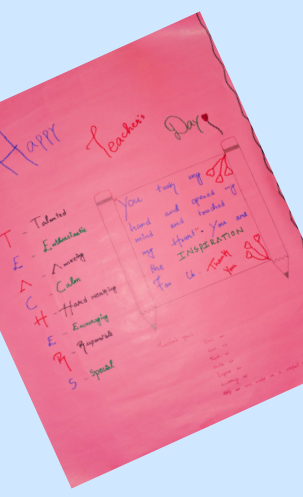




# Teachers Day Celebration

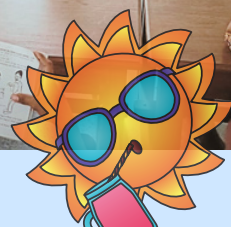

Our children from different age groups were taken to various places during their educational tours. A team of our staff members accompanied them. Each team have their own stories to share and here are few pictures from them.

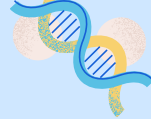






## CDP – Navodhaya Team

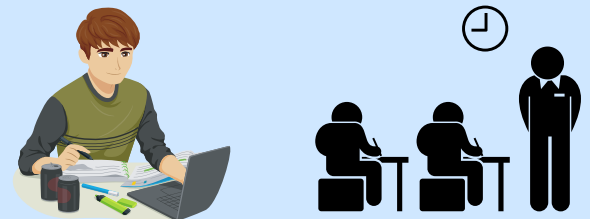
