A Legacy of Love and Sacrifice - 125th Anniversary Thanksgiving Service

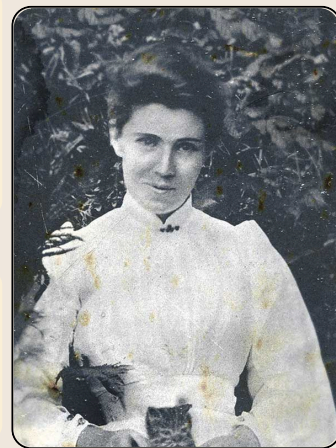

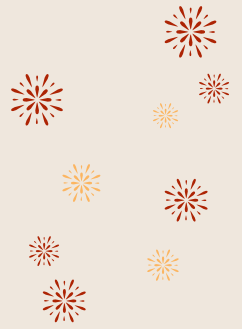
